

OPCAT visit to the Bóly-Görcsöny Joint Social Institution of Baranya County

On November 8–9, 2016, the staff members of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism Department paid a visit to the Bóly-Görcsöny Joint Social Institution of Baranya County.



The visit was aimed at examining the living conditions of the adult patients and disabled children residing in the Institution. The members of the visiting delegation inspected the premises of the Institution, conducted interviews with the personnel, the patients and their visitors. Catering to the residents was checked by an expert dietician.
