

OPCAT inspection in the Károlyi István Child Care Centre in Fót

On 21 July 2015 the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism paid a visit to the Special Foster Home for Children with Disabilities and Special Needs of the Károlyi István Child Care Centre.



The purpose of the visit was the inspection of the placement of and the care provided to children with disabilities and special needs, with regard to the enforcement of the prevention of torture, cruel and inhuman or degrading treatment and punishment. Since the visit had not been communicated in advance and at the time of our arrival children with disabilities were on holiday together with their caretakers, confidential interviews could be taken only with children with special needs and the personnel taking care of them.
