

OPCAT inspection in the Márianosztra Strict and Medium Regime Prison

On 13-14 March 2017 staff members of the Office of the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights conducted an unannounced OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism visit to the Márianosztra Strict and Medium Regime Prison.



The purpose of the visit was to inspect the treatment of detainees and the conditions of detention. The members of the delegation examined the material conditions, the relevant documents, and interviewed the detainees, the leadership of the institute, and the staff members.
