OPCAT visit to the

Holding Center of the Nógrád County Police Headquarters, the Detention Unit of the Salgótarján Police Department, and the Detention Unit of the Balassagyarmat Police Department

On January 30–31, 2018, colleagues of the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights, performing the tasks of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism, paid unannounced visits to three police detention facilities, the Holding Center of the Nógrád County Police Headquarters, the Detention Unit and other facilities of the Salgótarján Police Department, and the Detention Unit and other facilities of the Balassagyarmat Police Department.



The visit's objective was to examine the detainees' treatment and the conditions of their detention. The members of the visiting delegation inspected the buildings and the premises of the institutions, the relevant documents, and conducted interviews with the detainees, the management, and the members of the staff.
