OPCAT visit to the Chronic Aftercare Department of Unit III of Szeged Strict and Medium Regime Prison

On June 13-14, 2018 the staff members of the OPCAT NPM Department paid a visit to the Chronic Aftercare Department of Unit III of Szeged Strict and Medium Regime Prison.



The purpose of the visit was to inspect the conditions of placement of sick detainees in the Chronic Aftercare Department. The members of the visiting team conducted interviews with the management of the institution, staff members, and detainees, and they inspected the wards, the examination rooms of the Chronic Aftercare Department, and the premises of visitor reception areas. Medical experts examined the protocol of medical care of the detainees and the circumstances of nutrition of the patients.
