

**OPCAT Visit**  
**to the Tamási Police Station**  
**25 September 2020**

On 25 September 2020, the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights of Hungary, responsible for the tasks of the National Preventive Mechanism, and his colleagues paid a visit to the Tamási Police Station.



The purpose of the visit was to check the execution of the measures taken to prevent the spread of the coronavirus infection (COVID-19) and to remedy the harmful effects of the pandemic. The visiting group inspected the lock-up facility and the other premises of the police station, examined the disinfection methods and the protective gear for the police officers on duty. The members of the visiting group conducted interviews with the detainees, the members of the management and the staff, reviewed the relevant documentation and examined the vehicle for transporting the detainees.
