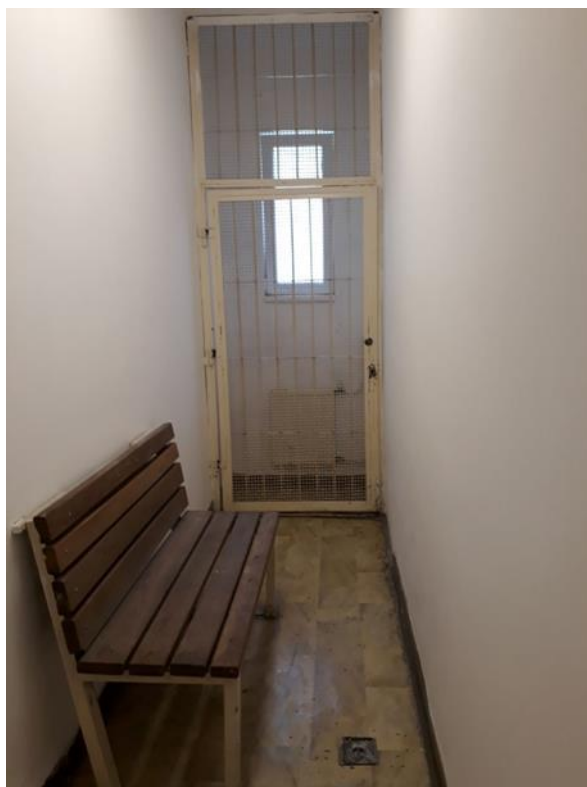


OPCAT visit

to the Martonvásár Police Station of the Gárdonyi Police Department
7 May 2020

On 7 May 2020, the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights, responsible for performing the tasks of the National Preventive Mechanism, and his colleagues paid a visit to the Martonvásár Police Station of the Gárdonyi Police Department.



The purpose of the visit was to check the execution of the measures taken to prevent the spread of the coronavirus infection (COVID-19) and to remedy the harmful effects of the pandemic. The visiting group inspected the lock-up facility and the other premises of the police station; examined the disinfection methods and the protective gear to equip the police officers on duty. The visiting group conducted interviews with the members of the management and the staff; examined relevant documents and the vehicle for transporting detainees.
