OPCAT visit to the Assisted Living Centre for the Elderly of the "Gondoskodás" Social Care Centre in Csáfordjánosfa 5 August 2021

On 5 August 2021, the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights of Hungary, responsible for performing the tasks of the National Preventive Mechanism, and his staff members paid an unannounced visit to the Assisted Living Centre for the Elderly of the "Gondoskodás" Social Care Centre in Csáfordjánosfa.



The purpose of the visit was to check the execution of the measures taken to prevent the spread of the coronavirus infection (COVID-19) and to remedy the harmful effects of the pandemic. The members of the visiting group conducted interviews with the residents, the members of the staff and the management, and they also reviewed the relevant documentation. The visiting group inspected the rooms and other premises of the Institution, and checked the ways in which the residents could keep contact with the outside world while visits were prohibited, and also the way the visits are held at present.
