

OPCAT visit
to the Győr-Moson-Sopron County Remand Prison
9 December 2021

On 9 December 2021, the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights of Hungary, responsible for performing the tasks of the National Preventive Mechanism, and his staff members paid a visit to the Győr-Moson-Sopron County Remand Prison.



The primary purpose of the visit was to inspect the measures taken to prevent the spread of the coronavirus infection (COVID-19) and to cope with the challenges of the pandemic. The members of the visiting group inspected the living conditions, conducted interviews with the detainees, the management, and the members of the staff, and reviewed the relevant documentation.
