OPCAT visit to the Baranya County Remand Prison

26 January 2021

On 26 January 2021, the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights of Hungary, responsible for performing the tasks of the National Preventive Mechanism, and his colleagues paid a visit to the Baranya County Remand Prison.





The purpose of the visit was to check the execution of the measures taken to prevent the spread of the coronavirus infection (COVID-19) and to remedy the harmful effects of the pandemic. The members of the visiting group conducted interviews with the detainees, members of the staff and the management and reviewed the relevant documentation. The visiting group examined the cell blocks of the Institution, the means of communication (Skype, telephone) used instead of the personal visitation being prohibited due to the outbreak.
