

**OPCAT visit  
to the Szabolcs-Szatmár-Bereg County Remand Prison**

**29 July 2021**

On 29 July 2021, the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights of Hungary, responsible for performing the tasks of the National Preventive Mechanism, and his colleagues paid a visit to the Szabolcs-Szatmár-Bereg County Remand Prison.



The purpose of this visit was to inspect the measures taken to prevent the spread of the coronavirus infection (COVID-19) and to cope with the challenges of the pandemic.

The purpose of the visit was to check the execution of the measures taken to prevent the spread of the coronavirus infection (COVID-19) and to remedy the harmful effects of the pandemic. The members of the visiting group conducted interviews with the detainees, members of the staff and the management and reviewed the relevant documentation. The visiting group examined the cell blocks of the Institution, the means of communication (Skype, telephone) and checked the circumstances of the personal visitation, available again since 1 July 2021.
