OPCAT NPM Visit to

Pálhalma National Prison

On 17 November 2022, the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights of Hungary, acting as the National Preventive Mechanism (hereinafter: NPM), and his staff visited the command building and the facility of the Pálhalma National Prison.







The purpose of the visit was to see the conditions of detainees' accommodation and employment opportunities in the sub-unit in Mélykút. The Pálhalma National Prison is one of the largest and the only four-unit facility in the country.
