OPCAT visit to the

"Viktória" Integrated Care Center of Szabolcs-Szatmár-Bereg County in Mándok and Fülpösdaróc, and at the Supported Living House No. 6 in Fülpösdaróc

24 March 2022 and 5 April 2022

On 24 March 2022 and on 5 April 2022, staff members of the Office of the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights of Hungary, who is responsible for performing the tasks of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism (NPM), paid visits to the "Viktória" Integrated Care Center of Szabolcs-Szatmár-Bereg County in Mándok and Fülpösdaróc, and at the Supported Living House No. 6 in Fülpösdaróc, close to the Ukrainian–Hungarian border.





The purpose of the visits was to investigate into the living conditions and treatment of the residents of these institutions, with special regard to the impact of the Ukrainian war situation on the social care services of the region. The members of the visiting group inspected the living conditions, conducted interviews with the residents, the members of the staff and the management, and reviewed the relevant documentation.
